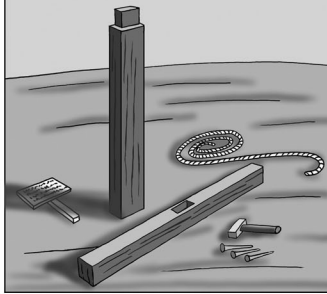
## FAITH FACTS

The Gospel Reading.

Crucifixion was the method used by the Romans to execute people. Often, the vertical part of the cross stayed in the ground. The prisoner carried the cross-beam to the place of execution. He might or might not be tied to the beam. At the place of execution he was nailed to cross-beam and the beam was slotted onto the upright. Then the victim's feet were nailed to the upright. In Jesus' case, a notice was fixed to the cross.

Crucifixion was a horrible and agonizing way in which to die.
